# ACHIEVEMENT GOAL 1, PERFORMANCE INDICATOR 1 FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME FRESHMEN FALL TO SPRING RETENTION RATE

The fall-to-spring retention rate for first-time, full-time freshman students with a first or second major in the Keeran School of Bible and Ministry (KSBM) will be equal to or greater than the fall to spring retention rate of the previous freshman cohort's fall to spring retention rate. The minimum threshold (71.9%) is equal to the KSBM 5-year average rate minus SD\*1. The aspirational goal (88.3%) is the average rate plus SD\*1 (SD=8.2). (Freshman Cohort Indicator)

#### Measure

Calculate the percentage of the first-time, full-time freshman cohort who return to spring semester following the first fall semester of attendance. Compare the percentage of return to the preceding year's return rate. Peer comparison data is not available for this indicator.

# **Outcome**

The KSBM fall-to-spring retention rate for the fall 2022 freshman cohort was 91.7% as compared to 75.0% for the fall 2021 cohort. The minimum threshold of 71.9% and the aspirational goal of 88.3% were both met. The fall 2022 KSBM fall-to-spring retention rate is above the institutional fall-to-spring retention rate (80.6%).

# ACHIEVEMENT GOAL 1, PERFORMANCE INDICATOR 2 FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME FRESHMEN FALL TO FALL RETENTION RATE

The fall-to-fall retention rate for first-time, full-time freshman students with either a first or second major from the Keeran School of Bible and Ministry (KSBM) will be equal to or greater than the previous freshman cohort's fall-to-fall retention rate. The minimum threshold (30%) is equal to the KCU 5-year average rate minus SD\*1. The aspirational goal (88%) is the AIKCU 5-year average rate plus SD\*1. (Freshman Cohort Indicator)

#### Measure

Calculate the percentage of the first-time, full-time freshman cohort who return to the following fall semester after the first fall semester of attendance. Compare the percentage of return to the preceding year's return rate.

## Outcome

The fall-to-fall retention rate for the fall 2022 freshman cohort was 92% as compared to 15% for the fall 2021 cohort and 70% for the fall 2020 cohort. The minimum threshold and aspirational goal were both met.



# ACHIEVEMENT GOAL 2, PERFORMANCE INDICATOR 1 FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME FRESHMEN GRADUATION RATES

The percentage of students who enter as first-time full-time freshmen and complete their degree within 150% of the typical time to complete a baccalaureate degree (6 years) will be equal to or greater than the previous cohort's completion rate. The aspirational goal (52.4%) is equal to the three-year average rate plus the STD\*1 and the minimum threshold (18.7%) is the average two-year mean score minus the STD\*1. (Freshman Cohort Indicator)

#### Measure

Calculate the total number and percentage completing the program within 150% of the normal timeframe.

### **Outcome**

The 2018 first-time, full-time student cohort had a completion rate of 55.2% within 150% of the typical time to complete a baccalaureate degree 6 years), as compared to 25.0% completion rate with the 2017 cohort. The aspirational goal was met.

# ACHIEVEMENT GOAL 2, PERFORMANCE INDICATOR 2 GRADUATE STUDENT GRADUATION RATES

The percentage of graduate students who complete their degree within 2.5 years will be equal to or greater than the previous cohort. The aspirational goal is equal to the five-year average rate plus STD\*1 (63.8%) and the minimum threshold is the five-year average rate minus STD\*1 (3.9%). (Graduate Student Cohort Indicator)

#### Measure

Calculate the total number and percentage completing the program within a 2.5-year timeframe.

## **Outcome**

The 2021 graduate student cohort had a completion rate of 33.3% within 2.5 years, as compared to 80.0% completion rate with the 2020 cohort. The minimum threshold was met and the completion rate within 2.5 years was comparable to the average of the last five years (33.9%). Two students have withdrawn; one of those withdrew at the beginning of the first semester. One student is still enrolled.

Undergraduate alumni will enroll in graduate school within two years of graduation as self-reported through an alumni survey. The minimum threshold is equal to the three-year average minus SD\*1. The aspirational goal is equal to the three-year average plus SD\*1. (Overall Population Indicator)

#### Measure

Evaluate the number of graduating students who enroll in graduate school within two years of undergraduate graduation. The measure will utilize a survey emailed to recent graduates.
